### General information

Race HQ and changing facilities is at McCandlish Hall, Straiton. The hall will be opened at 10am. Competitors are asked to park in the Forestry Commission car park and **not on the main road in front of the hotel, shops or houses**. There are public toilets behind the hall and also within the hall.

### Directions to HQ

The most convenient direction to approach Straiton is from the A77, south of Ayr. Approx ½ mile south of Minishant, turn left onto the B7045 Newton Stewart road and continue on this road through Kirkmichael to Straiton (approx 8 miles from A77). Coming from the south via Dumfries, take the A75 to Castle Douglas and then the A713 signposted Ayr until Dalmellington and then take left onto the B741 to Straiton just after Dalmellington.

### Start, Finish and Primes.

The start and finish are both at the Primary School, Straiton. Prime: On the first lap at summit of Nick of the Balloch. Hot spot sprint: Straiton village school at the end of lap one.

### Service:

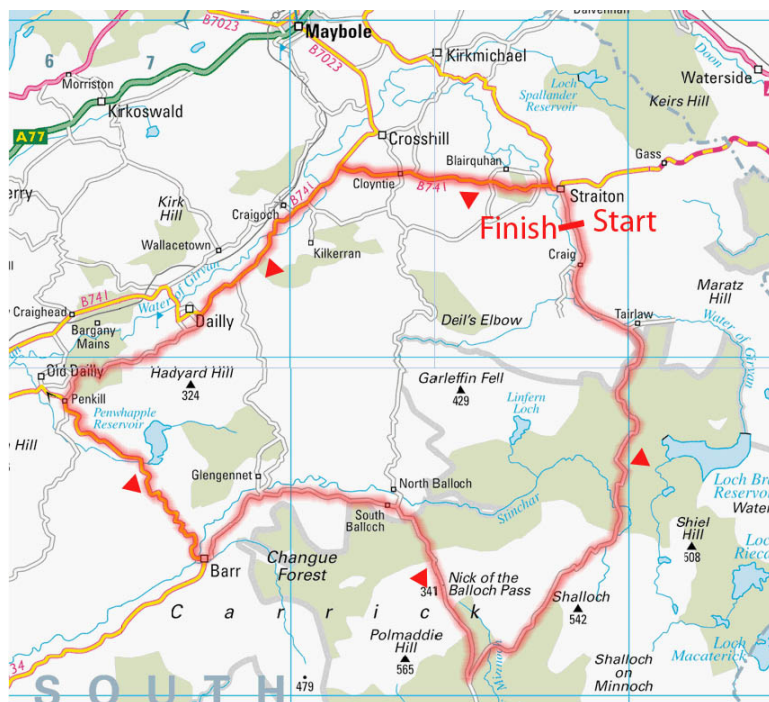
We intend to provide neutral service. Odd numbers should provide a front wheel and even numbers a rear wheel. Please ensure that your wheel is clearly marked with your name and club.

### Course:

Form at Primary School entrance, Straiton. Proceed north on B7045 directly through Straiton village. Turn first left onto B741, direction Cloyntie. Turn left then continue on B741 in direction of Girvan until junction for Penkill Castle. Turn left at this junction to Penkill and turn left onto B734 to Barr village. Proceed through village to turn left onto unclassified road to Balloch. At 'T' junction at South Balloch turn right to proceed up The Nick of the Balloch pass. Over summit, proceed to Rowantree Toll and turn left at junction. Proceed north to Straiton village. Proceed as previous circuit.

On the second and final lap, finish is at Straiton School.

Total distance approx 72miles.
